Subject: Clarification and Changes in CPPP Tender ID 2020_IISC_545723_1 (IISc Tender No.: IISc/ Purchase/RBCCPS/2020/03) – NIT for Supply and Installation of Network Test-bed equipment at Centre for Networked Intelligence, RBCCPS, Indian Institute of Science, Bangalore

Indian Institute of Science (IISc), Bangalore has issued a Notice Inviting Tender for Supply and Installation of Network Test-bed equipment at Centre for Networked Intelligence, RBCCPS, Indian Institute of Science, Bangalore vide above tender references through Central Public Procurement Portal (CPPP).

After pre-bid meeting held on 2nd March 2020, some revisions / clarifications in the Tender Document of the above-mentioned tender have been made based on the queries from prospective bidders as per following details:

Sl. No.	Clause No. /Page No. in NIT Document	Description (As in NIT Document)	Clarification / Revision (To be Read as)
1.	Page 4, Clause 4.3.5	Preventive Maintenance	For software maintenance: contents / conditions remain the same as per Clause 4.3.5 of NIT Addition: Preventive maintenance for hardware shall be as mandated by the OEM as per the operational manual for each specific equipment.
2.	Page 1, clause 1	Intra-Testbed network cabling	Intra testbed LAN cabling is bidder's responsibility, details of which are as follows: 1) All intra rack cabling between the supplied subsystems on the rack. 2) UTP LAN cabling from the rack location to networks lab – 50m on the same floor. 3) UTP LAN cabling from rack to WiFi access points (5 nos) – 40m each. Cables and connectors for Items 2 and 3 above should support 802.3bt PoE and 802.3bz standards. Bidders while quoting, should consider the above requirements, for which no separate claim of payment will be accepted.

Sl. No.	Clause No. /Page No. in NIT Document	Description (As in NIT Document)	Clarification / Revision (To be Read as)
3.	Page 2, Clause 3.1	Earnest Money Deposit (EMD)	EMD can be exempted for MSME bidders as per GFR. In this case, the MSME bidder must provide a valid MSME certificate from a competent government authority with the technical bid.
4.	Page 6, Clause 7	Payment terms	Remains unchanged.
5.	Page 4, Clause 4.3.7	Performance Security or Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG)	The validity of Performance Security or PBG should remain valid for a period of sixty days beyond the date of completion of all contractual obligations of the supplier including warranty obligations. In the present case, the PBG shall be valid for the duration of Support contract (three years from the date of successful installation and acceptance by IISc) plus two months. The PBG shall commence from the day of user acceptance. PBG through nationalized banks is preferred, however IISc may consider to accept PBG through RBI listed scheduled commercial bank in India upon request.
6.	Page 6, Clause 7	Addition of clause with respect to Penalty for late delivery or Liquidated Damage (LD)	As time is the essence for this procurement, hence the ordered materials are required to be delivered and installed in all respects within the stipulated period in the purchase order failing which penalty for late delivery and installation will be imposed at the rate 1% of the total order value per week or part thereof for the delayed period subject to maximum of 10% of the total order value and this liquidated damage will be deducted during the payment of the invoice / bill of the supplier. Earliest / expected delivery period should be clearly indicated in the technical bid.
7.	Page 4, Clause 4.3.4	SLA for Support Contract	The minimum SLA that the bidder is expected to satisfy is as per clause 4.3.4
8.	Page 5, Claus5.2	Currency to be quoted for imported items (considering customs and GST exemption for IISc)	Remains unchanged.

Rest of all the contents and terms & conditions of the NIT remain same.
