Deputation can be considered from the officers from the Central/ State Governments or Institute of national importance or Universities/ University level institution or PSU holding analogous post, and/or possessing educational qualification and experience as prescribed for direct recruitment

<u>Prescribed Minimum Educational Qualification / Experience:</u>

<u>Educational Qualifications:</u> M.E./M. Tech in Civil Engineering with 55% marks.

<u>Experience</u>: 8 years of experience as Assistant Project Engineer (APE) or an equivalent post in Govt/Autonomous bodies/PSU with a Grade Pay of Rs. 5400/-. However, those serving/served as Assistant Project Engineer on regular employment or on deputation at the institute for at least 8 years with M.E/M.Tech and exemplary service record can also apply [Age limit not applicable].

Desirable

<u>Experience</u>: Experience in development or operation or maintenance of a modern academic or corporate or similar infrastructure. Familiarity with modern practices in civil constructions and electrical power systems.

Terms and conditions:

1. The post of Deputy Project Engineer (Civil), is also suitable for Physically Handicapped candidates

- with disabilities viz. Orthopedically Handicapped/Locomotor disability/Cerebral Palsy with One Leg Affected (Right or Left) (OL) or One Arm Affected (Right or Left) (OA) and Hearing Impaired.
- 2. Relaxations in age is applicable to Persons with Disability and Ex-Servicemen as per Govt of India norms as applicable to the Institute. Maximum age relaxation is upto 55 years for the post.
- 3. The candidate must be a citizen of India.
- 4. The post of Deputy project Engineer is on Deputation basis for a period of 5 years. However, the period may be extended or curtailed on performance basis, functional requirements and guidelines followed by the Institute.
- Candidates have to apply online only. Incomplete applications in any respect will not be considered. No further correspondence will be entertained in this regard. Physical application will not be considered.
- 6. All the details filled in the online application will be treated as final and no changes shall be entertained thereafter and same will be taken into consideration for the whole recruitment process. Uploaded documents to be clear and visible.
- 7. Candidates, who have submitted experience certificates from PSU / Autonomous bodies having different pay scales, should mandatorily submit equivalence certificate for consideration of their experience. Else, experience would not be considered.
- 8. Certificate(s) in support of experience(s) should be as per the format attached. It should be on the employer's organization's letter head bearing the date of issue.
- 9. The prescribed qualifications and experience are the minimum required and the mere fact that a candidate possesses the same will not entitle him/her for being called for an interview. The Institute reserves the right to restrict the no. of candidates admitted for interview to a reasonable number, on the basis of educational qualifications and/or experience.
- 10. Selection for the post will be through interview. However, Institute reserves the right conduct a written exam, if required.
- 11. All Candidates should obtain NOC from the present employer (wherever applicable) and upload online. However, application without NOC will also be considered provided the candidate uploads a duly signed undertaking that the NOC will be submitted at the time of Interview.
- 12. Applications should be submitted well in advance, without waiting until the last date.
- 13. Call letters to attend the interview will be sent only to the short-listed candidates by mail. Candidates are required to check their registered mail frequently. No correspondence will be made with applicants who are not short-listed/not called for interview.
- 14. The Institute reserves the right to reject any application without assigning any reason. The Institute also reserves the right to cancel the advertisement/recruitment at any stage due to any administrative reason. No correspondence will be entertained in this regard.
- 15. The institute reserves the right to conduct the interview online or in-person. Out station candidates called for interview will be paid railway fare in 2ndA/C from the place of duty/residence to Bengaluru and back by shortest route on production of tickets.
- 16. During the period of service, every employee shall observe, obey and abide by the Scheme, Regulations and Byelaws (SRB), Administrative Manuals, other statutory documents, CCS (Conduct) Rules and CCS (CCA) Rules etc.
- 17. Those who are joining the Institute service on or after 1st January 2004 are covered under the new pension scheme. However, employees who entered service before 31.12.2003 and who were governed by the CCS (Pension) Rules, 1972 shall be eligible for the GPF-cum-Pension-cum-Gratuity scheme subject to fulfillment of the conditions prescribed for this purpose by the Govt of India.

- 18. The Institute reserves the right to verify the antecedents or documents submitted by the candidate at any time during the service. In case it is found that the documents submitted by the candidate are not genuine, then his/her services shall be terminated, and disciplinary/criminal proceedings will be initiated.
- 19. Candidates who are awarded gradations under CGPA/GPA system in respect of Master's and Bachelor's Degree are advised to submit correct percentage of marks obtained as per the University/Institute guidelines for conversion of CGPA/GPA to appropriate percentage. The proof (letter issued by the University/Institute) of the same will be submitted during the document verification.
- 20. The details filled-in by the applicants in the application form will be duly verified before publishing the results. If the candidates fail to provide the authentic proof for the details filled-in by them, their candidature will be summarily forfeited.
- 21. Any dispute with regard to the selection process will be subject to Honourable Court/Tribunal having jurisdiction over Bangalore.
- 22. In case of any ambiguity/dispute arises on account of interpretation between the English and other language versions of the notification, instructions detailed in the English version shall be final.
- 23. The recruitment portal will be open from 24/06/2023 to 23/07/2023 for submission of applications online.
