Essential Qualifications:

- Bachelor's or Master's degree in a relevant scientific field such as Health Physics, Medical Physics, or Radiological Sciences
- RSO Training from AERB is mandatory
- In-depth knowledge of AERB and other relevant regulatory requirements

Job description:

The responsibilities of the selected candidates include (but are not limited to)

- Ensuring compliance with AERB and other regulations and commissioning of Radiology Imaging, Radiotherapy and Nuclear Medicine departments.
- Demonstrating proficiency in installation and smooth operations of X-Ray, CT, MRI, Fluoroscopy, C-Arm, Brachytherapy, LINAC, TPS, Nuclear medicine equipment including PET-CT and SPECT
- Implementing radiation safety programs across the organisation.
- Participate in all relevant academic activities of the organisation.
