## **SECTION 2 - ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

#### Prequalification criteria:

- 1. The Bidder's firm should have existence for a minimum of 3 years. (Enclose Company Registration Certificate).
- 2. The Bidder should have qualified technical service personnel for the instrument(s) based in India.
- 3. If the Bidder is a local distributor/dealer/Agent, it is mandatory to attach authorization certificate along with the bid from the original equipment manufacturer.
- 4. The bidder should sign and submit the declaration for Acceptance of Terms and Conditions as per Annexure 4.
- 5. The Bidder must not be blacklisted/banned/suspended or have a record of any service-related dispute with any organization in India or elsewhere. A declaration to this effect has to be given as per Annexure 3.
- 6. Quote should come only from Indian Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM) or Indian authorized distributor of OEM.
- 7. The quotations should be on FOR-IISc Bangalore basis in INR only. OR equipment should be quoted in the currency of the country of origin, and all locally sourced items should be quoted in Indian Rupees.
- 8. The Bidder should belong to either Class-1 or Class-2 suppliers distinguished by their "local content" as defined by recent edits to GFR. They should mention clearly which class they belong to in the cover letter. a) Class-1 supplier: Goods and services should have local content of equal to or more than 50%. b) Class-2 supplier: Goods and services should have local content of equal to or more than 20 % and less than 50%.
- 9. Bidders offering imported products will fall under the category of non-local suppliers. They cannot claim themselves as Class-1 local suppliers/Class-2 local suppliers by claiming the services such as transportation, insurance, installation, commissioning, training, and other sales service support like AMC/CMC, etc., as local value addition.
- 10. Purchase preference as defined by the recent edits to GFR (within the "margin of purchase preference") will be given to the Class-1 supplier.
- 11. MSMEs can seek an exemption to some qualification criteria. IISc follows GFR2017 for such details.

#### SECTION 3 — TERMS AND CONDITIONS

#### (A) Submission of Tender:

- 1. All documentation in the tender should be in English.
- 2. Tender should be submitted in two envelopes (two bid system).
  - a. Technical Bid (Part-A) -

Technical bid consisting of all technical details, checklist for conformance to specifications, format in which the price bid is quoted without the actual prices (suppliers who include any indication of prices in the technical bid will be automatically disqualified).

b. Commercial Bid (Part-B) -

Indicating item-wise price for the items mentioned in the technical bid, as per the format of quotation provided in the tender, and other commercial terms and conditions.

- 3. The technical bid and price bid should each be placed in a sealed cover, superscripting on both the envelopes the tender No. and the due date and both these sealed covers are to be placed in a bigger cover which should also be sealed and duly superscripted with the Tender No & Due Date.
- 4. The SEALED COVER superscripting tender number / due date & should reach "The Chair, Central Animal Facility, Indian Institute of Science, Bangalore, Karnataka- 560012, India" on or before due date mentioned in the tender notice. In case due date happens to be holiday the tender will be accepted and opened on the next working day. If the quotation cover is not sealed, it will be rejected.
- 5. All communications are to be addressed to- "The Chair, Central Animal Facility, Indian Institute of Science, Bangalore, Karnataka-560012, India.
- 6. GST/other taxes, levies etc., are to be indicated separately. The BIDDER should mention GST Registration and PAN in the tender document (Indian Bidders only).
- 7. If price is not quoted in Commercial Bid as provided in tender document the bid is liable to be rejected.
- 8. The Institute reserves the right to accept or reject any bid and to annul the bidding process and reject all bids at any time prior to the award of contract, without there by incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders or any obligation to inform the affected bidder or bidders.
- 9. Incomplete bids will be summarily rejected.
- B) Cancellation of Tender:

Notwithstanding anything specified in this tender document, IISc Bangalore, in its sole discretion, unconditionally and without having to assign any reason, reserves the rights:

- a. To accept OR reject lowest tender or any other tender or all the tenders.
- b. To accept any tender in full or in part.
- c. To reject the tender, offer not confirming to the tender terms.

#### C) Validity of the Offer:

The offer shall be valid 120 Days from the date of opening of the commercial bid.

## D) Evaluation of Offer:

- 1. The technical bid (Part A) will be opened first and evaluated.
- 2. Bidders meeting the required criteria as stated in Section 2 of this document shall only be considered for Commercial Bid (Part B) opening. Further, agencies not furnishing the documentary evidence as required will not be considered.
- 3. Pre- qualification of the bidders shall not imply final acceptance of the Commercial Bid. The agency may be rejected at any point during technical evaluation or during commercial evaluation. The decision in regard to acceptance and / or rejection of any offer in part or full shall be the sole discretion of IISc Bangalore, and decision in this regard shall be binding on the bidders.
- 4. The award of contract will be subject to acceptance of the terms and conditions stated in this tender.
- 5. Any offer which deviates from the vital conditions (as illustrated below) of the tender is liable to be rejected:
  - a. Non-submission of complete offers.
  - b. Receipt of bids after due date and time and or by email / fax (unless specified otherwise).
  - c. Receipt of bids in open conditions.
- In case any BIDDER is silent on any clauses mentioned in these tender documents, IISc Bangalore shall construe that the BIDDER had accepted the clauses as of the tender and no further claim will be entertained.
- 7. No revision in the terms and conditions quoted in the offer will be entertained after the last date and time fixed for receipt of tenders.
- 8. Lowest bid will be calculated based on the total price of all items tendered for Basic equipment along with accessories for installation, operation, pre-processing and post processing, optional items, recommended spares, warranty, annual maintenance contract.

#### E) Pre-requisites:

The bidder will provide the prerequisite installation requirements along with the technical bid.

#### H) Warranty:

The complete system is to be under warranty for a period of minimum 5 years (1 year + minimum 4 years extended warranty, including free supply of consumables, spare parts and data analysis software from the date of functional installation. If the equipment is found to be defective, it has to be rectified or when required replace required parts/components at the cost of the bidder within 15 days from the date of receipt of written communications from IISc, Bangalore. If there is any delay in replacement or rectification, the warranty period should be correspondingly extended.

I) Comprehensive/Annual Maintenance Contract: NA

#### J) Purchase Order:

- 1. The order will be placed on the bidder whose bid is accepted by IISc based on the terms & conditions mentioned in the tender document.
- 2. The quantity of the items in tender is only indicative. IISc, Bangalore reserves the right to increase /decrease the quantity of the items depending on the requirement.
- 3. If the quality of the product and service provided is not found satisfactory, IISc, Bangalore reserves the right to cancel or amend the contract.

### K) Delivery and Installation:

The bidder shall provide the lead time to delivery, installation and made functional at IISc, Bangalore from the date of receipt of purchase order. The system should be delivered, installed and made functional within 90 days from the date of receipt of purchase order. The supply of the items will be considered as effected only on satisfactory installation and inspection of the system with all the items and features/capabilities tested by the IISc, Bangalore. After successful installation and inspection, the date of taking over of entire system by the IISc, Bangalore shall be taken as the start of the warranty period.

#### L) Payment Terms:

The payment will be processed after receiving and successful installation of the item.

#### M) Statutory Variation:

Any statutory increase in the taxes and duties subsequent to bidder's offer, if it takes place within the original contractual delivery date, will be borne by IISc, Bangalore subject to the claim being supported by documentary evidence. However, if any decrease takes place the advantage will have to be passed on to IISc, Bangalore.

#### N) Disputes and Jurisdiction:

Any legal disputes arising out of any breach of contract pertaining to this tender shall be settled in the court of competent jurisdiction located within the city of Bangalore, India.

#### O) General:

- 1. All amendments, time extension, clarifications etc., within the period of submission of the tender will be communicated electronically. No extension in the bid due date/time shall be considered on account of delay in receipt of any document(s) by mail.
- 2. The bidder may furnish any additional information, which is necessary to establish capabilities to successfully complete the envisaged work. It is however, advised not to furnish superfluous information.
- 3. The bidder must visit the installation site before submission of tender, with minimum 3-4 days prior intimation.

## **Technical Specification for Cage Changing Station**

1	Supply and installation of Dual Access Cage changing station electrically operated cage changing station for changing rat/mice cages in controlled barrier environment.
2	Cage Changing Station
	- Cage changing station body should be made up of Stainless Steel (SS304 or higher
	grade) with overall dimensions as L 1300-1400 mm X W 740-780 mm X H 1900-2100 mm.
	- For Animal Change Station with Hydraulic arrangements
	- Cage changing station should have electro-hydraulic height adjustable working top to lift
	the unit height up to 250-300 mm as per operators need.
3	It should be Dual Access Animal Workstation.
4	It should be ergonomically designed, easy to move with minimum efforts and all the corners
	should be properly rounded for operator's safety. Equipment should not have any sharp edges.
5	Equipment should be fitted with free moving castors wheels for easy manoeuvrability and minimum two wheels should be provided with lock/brake pads.
6	Working cabinet should be fitted with transparent polycarbonate/acrylic sturdy shield on both the sides.
7	Controls: Programmable logical controller with data logger with HMI and data logger.
	- Equipment should have Touch Screen display with Data Logging Facility.
	- It should have functional audio and visual alarms for operational conditions outside the
	set parameters like Laminar air flow speed, barrier air flow speed and filter
	efficiency/life
8	The barrier air flow speed should be high enough to protect the operator from allergens and
	particles coming from the cages, manipulated inside the cabinet. The average laminar air flow
	/velocity must be in the range of 0.4 to 0.8 m/s.
9	Working platform should be smooth, easily cleanable and should be made of SS304 or higher grade material.
10	Work surface and air flow grill should be removable for easy cleaning.
11	Collection tank should be removable to drain all the bedding and food particles accumulated
	underneath the work surface.

12	Work Area should be illuminated with switchable fluorescent lamp for efficient lighting.
13	Supply and exhaust air should be filtered through a particulate pre-filter and then through a HEPA filter.
14	Supply air & Exhaust air pre-filter should be easily accessible and cleanable/washable.
15	HEPA Filter should have typical efficiency as per Filter Class H14 (retention 99.995%) or better and DOP certification for HEPA filters is mandatory.
16	Protective net should be provided to avoid bedding and dust particles clogging the exhaust pre- filter and HEPA filter.
17	All the required pre-filter and HEPA filters (supply & exhaust) should be included.
	All the pre-filters and HEPA filters should be of appropriate size as per working chamber.
18	- Electrical supply available: 230V A.C, single phase, 50 Hz.
	2  nos. - 5/15  Amp.  3  pin power sockets should be present in the working area
19	Supplier must have minimum 10 installations in India in past 3 years.
20	Qualification and Documentation:

	HEPA filter test, vibration level, noise level, Air velocity test, DOP Test

- 3. The vendor will be responsible for the complete installation, testing and handover.

Training on usage of the machine (hardware) must be demonstrated by the successful bidder free of cost at bidder's cost to the end users at IISc, Bangalore.
